4	Copy of Romero Britto's work	Be able to create a copy of the artist's work with felt pens, using line, shapes, colour and pattern. Developing skills on how to create the artist style.	Oral responses in class Homework Marking feedback against the success criteria and marking matrix
5	Outline drawing based on your country	Be able to draw a piece of work based on your home country, that creates a word/scene, using a Romero Britto style. Drawing skills to create the outline, using line, pattern and shape.	Homework Oral feedback against the success criteria
6	Applying base colours	Be able to add the base colours to your drawing, using felt pens. Develop knowledge on base colours and top colours.	Oral responses in class

7	Apply pattern/top colours and outline	Be able to add pattern/top colours to your drawing in the style of Romero Britto. Be able to add a black outline in a Romero Britto style.	Homework Students use the marking matrix correctly to improve outcome
8	Evaluation and corrections	Be able to create an evaluation of the Romero Britto outcome using the success criteria, then be able to use the evaluation to improve the final outcome.	Written responses in evaluation Students use the marking matrix correctly to improve outcome
