Pre-Prep Department

Our Pre-Prep Department consists of Nursery and Reception classes and educates children between the ages of three and five in a series of bright, colorful, self-contained classrooms centred around a large library and indoor play space. Each classroom is fully equipped with quality learning materials; and enjoys its own tree-lined, secure playground with superb outdoor play equipment.

Both the Nursery and Reception classes follow the British Early years Foundation Stage Curriculum (EYFS), which is based upon the seven areas of Learning and Development and includes communication and language, personal, social, emotional and physical development. Almost all of our activities are based on structured play and exploring, which allow the children to develop their essentials skills in areas of literacy, mathematics and expressive arts.

Our imaginative role play topics are changed regularly and encompass all areas of learning. Maths is best taught in our role play 'Post Office', sorting parcels by size and weight and our French café is beneficial for developing basic foreign language skills.

Languages are taught from Nursery onwards by specialist teachers, with an introduction to Arabic and French and all children receive specialist tuition for PE. Teaching Assistants support the class teachers and the ratio in our Pre-Prep is never more than 1:10.



A closer look at our Primary Education...

Prep Department

Pupils in Years 1 to 6 are taught by their class teachers and supported by Teaching Assistants for the core subjects of Maths, English, Science and Computing. Whilst Music, PE and Languages are taught by specialist subject teachers in dedicated classrooms.

Our curriculum is further extended to include a wide range of subjects including, History, Geography, Art and Design and Design and Technology. Pupils in the Prep School also benefit from access to Science and Design and Technology laboratories which further enhance the teaching and learning.

By the end of Year 6, all of our pupils are well prepared both academically and socially for the excitement and new challenges of Secondary School.
















Secondary School....

The Secondary School runs from Year 7 to Year 12 through Key Stage 3 (Year 7 to 9), Key Stage 4 (Year 10 and 11) and Key Stage 5 (Year 12). When pupils move into the Secondary School they are taught by individual subject teachers and classes are more focused on formal subject based learning IGCSE and A Level examinations are taken at the end of Key Stage 4 and Key Stage 5 respectively.

As pupils get older and move into Key Stage 4, they begin to focus on their preferred subjects and IGCSE exams are taken at the end of this stage in different subjects.

In Key Stage 5, the Secondary School remains firmly committed to traditional A Levels which are accepted by universities around the world. Pupils who have successfully completed their IGCSEs will select their preferred subjects to study in Year 12 which will prepare them for university and then the start of their careers. Their subject selection at this stage will influence their choice of degree

course at university. We take pride in supporting all our pupils through the exciting choices and the hard work that goes into their last year at the RGSGQ.

Although mindful of the demands of formal examinations towards the latter part of Secondary School, the emphasis remains on encouraging pupils to explore beyond the formal curriculum and to continue to develop a true love of learning. Universities are increasingly looking at the whole person, not just examination results. At RGSGQ, we take pride in our pupil's academic success and their pathway to university. However, our commitment to their growth goes beyond that. We strive to equip our students with the skills and values needed to become not only successful professionals but also compassionate, responsible parents, partners, and friends.

Languages

In accordance with the Ministry of Education in Qatar, all Qatari pupils receive Arabic language lessons with a specialist Arabic teacher. Children also benefit from non-native and French lessons. Islamic Studies is available to our Muslim pupils and all pupils are taught the History of Qatar from Year 1.

Music, Sport & Art

We are fortunate to enjoy fantastic music and sports facilities at the RGSGQ, as well as plenty of large, open spaces in which to practice and perform. We have a dedicated Music Room, an Art Room an impressive Sports Hall, a large all weather sports pitch, athletics track and

undercover basketball courts. Pupils also benefit from swimming lessons throughout the year as part of their PE curriculum.

The sound of music can be heard throughout the School and plays an important part in school life. All of our pupils receive specialist music tuition and we offer a range of practical and theoretical music lessons. We are introducing opportunities to study various instruments and to join the school choir and bands.

All pupils enjoy creative art lessons and their handiwork can be seen adorning the school walls and noticeboards. Displaying and celebrating our pupil's work is essential for building confidence and developing a sense of pride and competition.

At The RGSGQ, learning extends beyond the classroom school events, visiting speakers special topics, visits and trips play an important role throughout the School. We celebrate International Week, Book Week, Maths and Science Days as well as visiting local museums, farms and parks. Older pupils enjoy an annual residential trip and pupils enjoy day trips connected to curriculum topics.

Extra-Curricular

An extended day is available to all of our pupils, including our Nursery and Reception classes who can attend after school crèche.

Technology

At RGSGQ, modern technology in the classroom is vital and complements our traditional teaching methods, both of which are fundamental in providing an essential balance of long established values and progressive learning.

Interactive whiteboards throughout the School are a perfect teaching tool to engage learners and bring lessons to life. Pupils also benefit from the use of tablet devices, programmable robots and access to a dedicated IT suite.

The result is that pupils progress rapidly in IT skills across the year groups, from games and eBooks in Nursery, to producing presentations, animations and videos in the later stages of the Prep Department and in Secondary School.


The Community

Admissions

Admission to the School is by assessment, which we make as informal as possible, with most children not even realising they are being assessed at all. We feel this helps reduce the stress of the assessment process for both parents and children.

Our assessments consist of our younger children being assessed by observation at play within the classroom setting and children usually have so much fun some don't want to leave. We recommend that, where possible, such observations take place at your child's current nursery. Our Head of School will happily visit your child at his/her Nursery at a time which is mutually convenient. This ensures the observation takes place in a setting familiar to your child where he/she feels comfortable and secured. It can also be more convenient for parents as they do not need to attend the assessment and can drop their child at Nursery as normal. We ask that Prep and Secondary School pupils visit us at the RGSGQ.

We ensure that all of the children are happy and relaxed at the start of the assessments, beginning with a conversation to find out more about each individual. Prep children will work with our Head of School or Deputy Head on Mathematics and English activities while Secondary School pupils complete an online assessment which provides a standardised measure of cognitive reasoning ability.

Whilst assessing the children is essential, we are also aware that anxious children are unable to perform to their best potential. It is for this reason that we also conduct our tests year round, often on a one-to-one basis and never more than a few children in an assessment group at a time.

We are located just off the Al Shamal Road, a few minutes drive from IKEA and Doha Festival City and approximately 10 minutes drive from Landmark.
