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Rationale

At RGSGQ we want to share our classrooms as much as possible with our parents we also want to highlight positive behaviours and use class dojo as a way to engage with the whole school community. We know the more we communicate with parents the more they will trust us and the happier they will be. We also know they will engage more in the education of their children and this will benefit our students.

What	When/How Often
Add the following staff to your class: - All year group and phase teachers - Specialist Teachers - Year Leads from phase - Deputy Heads - Head of Primary	Prep week
Accept invitation to House Points Class	Prep Week
Register on class dojo, create a class QR code and send it out to all families.	First day of the new school year and for any new students.
Follow up with an email to share your email address in case there are any issues.	First Thursday of the new school year and for any new students.
Call home to connect any missing students and parents	End of second week.
Minimum of 2 posts per week sharing work from class, celebrating class activities, learning and behaviour.	2 times per week
Weekly Newsletter	Every Thursday
Dojo points	Daily
Set homework	Once per week
Check and reply to messages from parents every morning before 7:15am. You must reply within 24 hours.	Daily
Celebrate Success - share pictures of students who have won	Every Thursday
<i>Share photos, interesting posts, positive comments on the learning in the class, games quizzes, recommendations for things to do to support learning and educational activities in Doha.</i>	Optional

Dojo and House points

Dojo points are completely at the classroom teacher's discretion. Add positive ones daily to encourage good behaviour and outcomes.

Award for good learning, good behaviour, whole class efforts, remember those who always do the right thing and remember as

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long as you name the specific behaviour or action you are praising you never give too many.

Do not take points away for poor behaviour.

At the end of the week celebrate winners as individuals or tables, then reset.

Class Dojo is for in-class rewards only. Children work individually and as a class to obtain as many points as possible in return for rewards.

House Points will be rewarded for school values outside of the classroom including in the hallways and outside play areas. Refer to positive behaviour policy for further detail.
